

LYME DISEASE is currently defined as an acute, recurrent, inflammatory infection transmitted by a tickborne spirochete, *Borrelia burgdorferi* found mostly in North America. There are other tickborne diseases mostly found in other parts of the world.

Officially speaking, because this is classified as a spirochete disease, it falls in the category of Treponema disease. See Spirochete Diseases elsewhere. There is great tiredness, soreness, malaise, headaches, chills and fever. It starts with pains in the shoulder joints where it is mistaken for bursitis or rotator cup problems. It travels to the knees where it is commonly mistaken for rheumatism. Sometimes it is involved in temporomandibular joints (where jawbones meet). Long-term cases go to the intestines where it engenders both an entero bacteria and an entero based virus (ECHO). Occasionally there are reddish skin blotch eruptions that move around. The symptoms are similar to many tickborne diseases across the world.

Our protocol for Lyme Disease includes:

Spirochete in herbal and homeopathic forms in the US, homeopathic only in Europe.

Tick Toxins which include the antidotes for *Borrelia Burgdorferi*, *Babesia Microti*, *Babesia Divergens* and *Babesia Bovis*.

Enterobacteriaceae for long term cases (3 or more years) expanding to the intestines.

ECHO as the companion to enterobacteriaceae for long term cases that have expanded to the intestines.

Ehrlichiosis for the form of Lyme that settles in the liver, carried mostly by dogs.

Complications include **Tick Heritage** in cases where there is a miasmatic relationship to tickborne diseases. Just as **Teeth Spirochetal** seems to feed the issue and deepen symptoms via the nerves of the teeth, **Spirochete Encephalitis** seems to cover the issues that go deeper into the body nerves. **Tick Poisons** is made for a collection of common dross of the toxins from the bacteria. **Spirochete/Hanta/Parvo** will often attack the kidneys (especially of females) giving great tiredness.

A "lookalike" combination causing similar tiredness along with achiness of bones and muscles. **Coxsackie G** along with **Q Fever**. Another look-alike is the **Colti** virus that causes Rocky Mountain Spotted Fever.

Coxsackie G is a virus that acts like the grandfather of all coxsackie viruses. It complicates Genital and Oral Herpes. It is not currently known in other sciences. It is generally more pervasive than might be imagined.

Q Fever comes from *Coxiella Burnetii* and is part of the Rickettsiaceae family. It is associated with livestock exposure. Symptoms start with a high fever, chills, headaches, cough and headaches, often with gastrointestinal problems. It can develop into a chronic endocarditis (heart condition) causing chronic hepatitis, aneurysms and osteomyelitis.
